



THE NATIONAL COMPETITION FOR LOVE PROSE "YOUNG STORYTELLER" IN MEMORY OF ATANAS RADOYNOV 2022 HAS ENDED

The sixth edition of the National Competition for Love Prose "Young Storyteller", which is held in memory of the writer Atanas Radoynov, has ended. The competition was established by the Burgas Writers' Association, the Municipality of Burgas and the Radoinov family in 2017.

This year the competition was attended by 47 young authors in two age groups: from 18 to 25 and from 26 to 35 years.

A jury consisting of: Diana Radoynova, Nikolay Fenerski and Yancho Cholakov determined the winners of the Young Storyteller Award.

One author from each of the two age groups received a one-time scholarship in the amount of BGN 200 and a Diploma from the Municipality of Burgas.

Two additional awards will be presented: "Friends of Atanas Radoinov" (Diploma from BPO and cash prize) and an invitation from the Chitalishte "Lyuben Karavelov 1940" to participate in the International Literary Festival "Holy Word" in Burgas in May 2022.
